There are three exhibitions opening during this internship: <u>Trailblazers: The Creative Story Behind Mountain Biking in Santa Cruz</u> (Install weeks: Jan 13 - 30, 2020), *Beyond the World's End* (Install weeks: Fed 24 - March 6, 2020), and the *Diversity Pod* in the History Gallery (Install weeks: Mar 23 - Apr 3, 2020).

You'll also learn how to use a drill, paint, and hang and handle artwork. **Overview**: Support interdisciplinary exhibitions at the Santa Cruz Museum of Art and History. Assist in

exhibition planning, prototyping in-gallery participatory activities, fabrication, help maintain the galleries, assist with installation and de-installation, and actively represent the MAH in the community.

What you'll be doing: Assist with installation and deinstallation of exhibitions.

- Assist with un-facilitated activities and projects throughout the museum.
- Learn museum gallery maintenance skills.
- Attend and actively contribute to intern meetings with staff supervisor, brainstorms, and exhibition partners.
- Actively and enthusiastically represent the MAH in the community.
- Attend and actively contribute to team meetings with the exhibits team.
